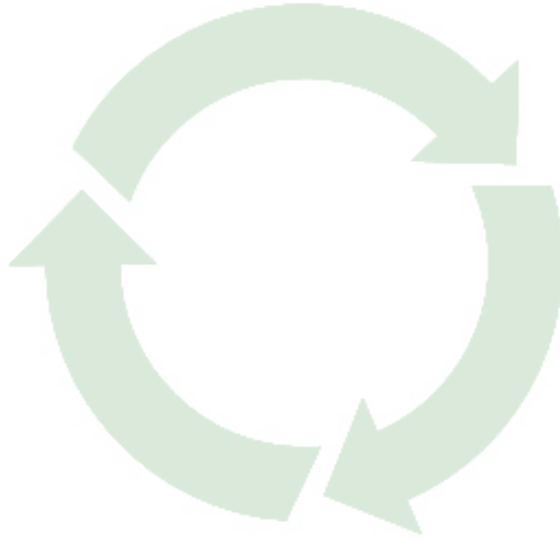


100% of our produce is USDA Certified organic and non-GMO
